Taco Bake

1 lb ground beef (or ground turkey) browned & drained

1 can tomato sauce

1/2 cup milk

1 can of red kidney beans (optional), drained

1 cup of shredded cheddar cheese

3/4 to 1 cup of salsa

4-6 tortilla shells cut into 1 inch squares

Add tomato sauce, salsa, milk and kidney beans to meat, keeping low temperature on skillet. Add milk and cheese. Add in cut tortilla slowly and mix well. Add any seasonings you like, such as cilantro, peppers, etc. Put entire mixture in casserole dish and bake at 375 degrees for approx 45 minutes or until bubbling hot. If you have any shredded cheese left, add to top and put back in oven for 5 minutes. Serve
